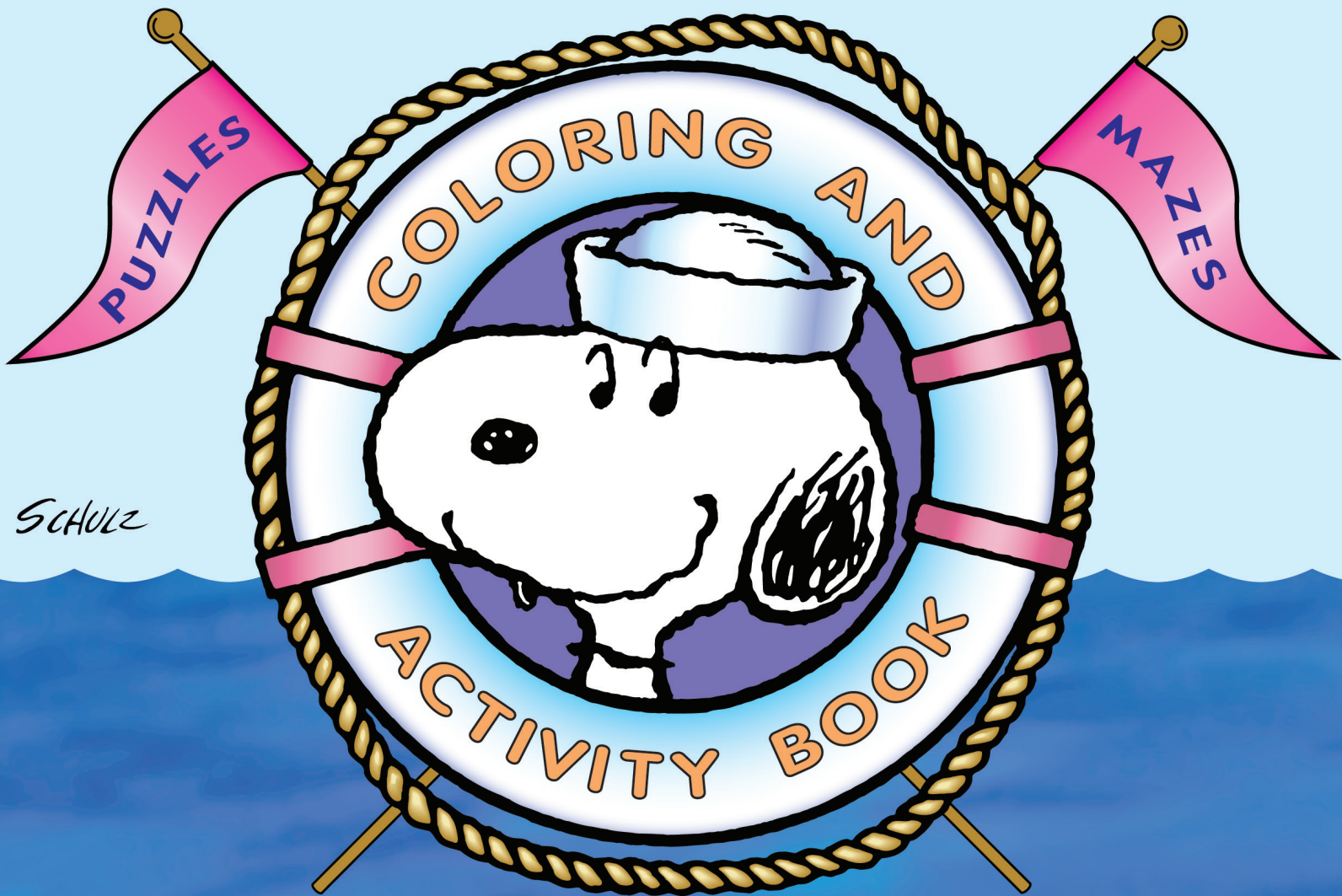

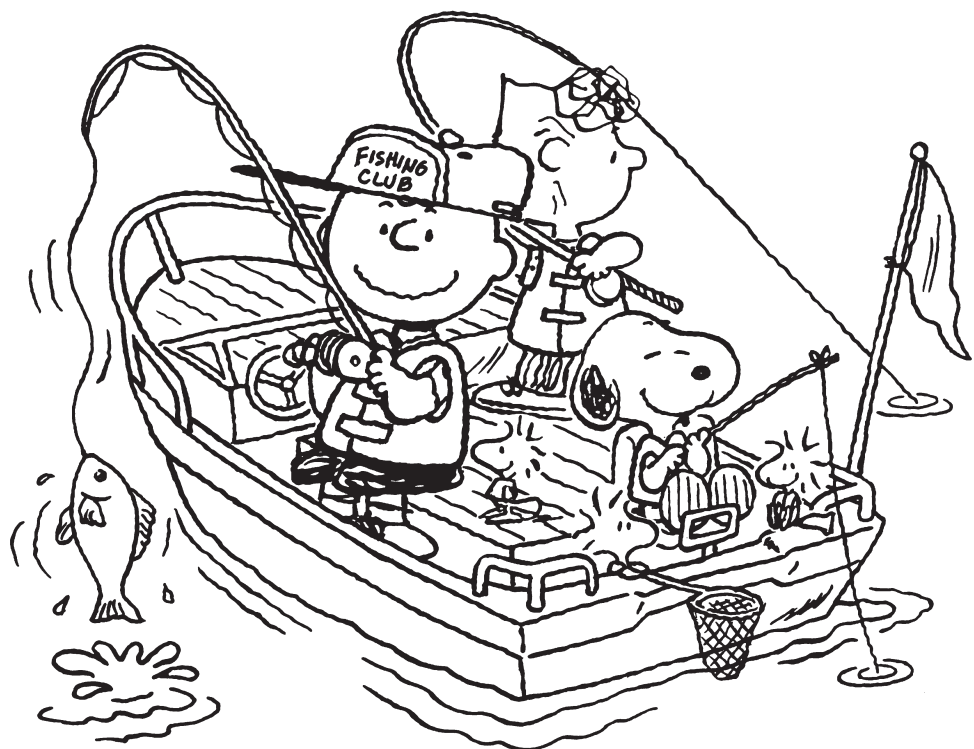

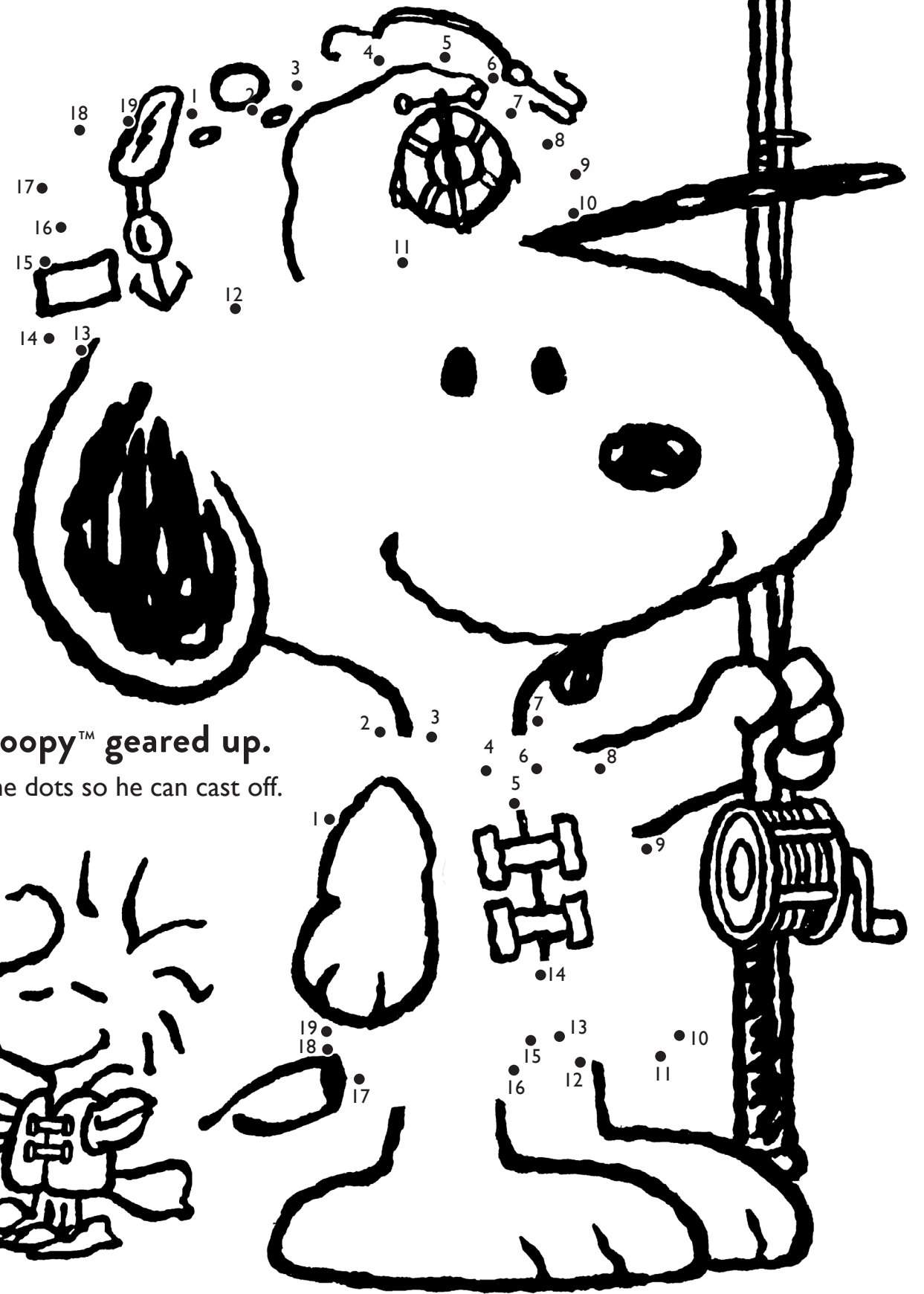
What a fun fishing trip!

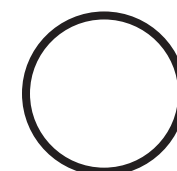


Three kids need to adjust their life jackets.

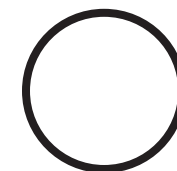

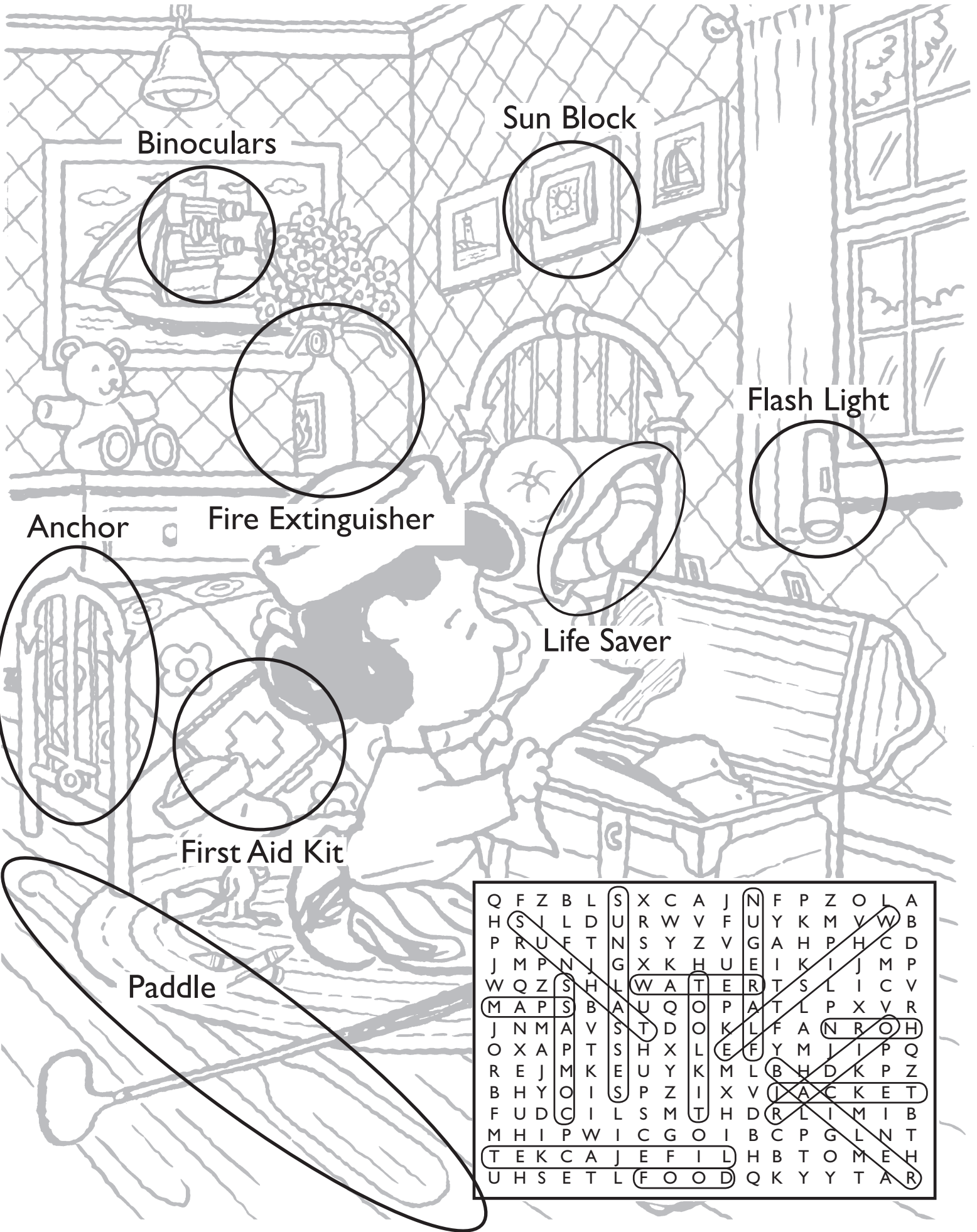


Flag the Four Boats that Are Being Unsafe.

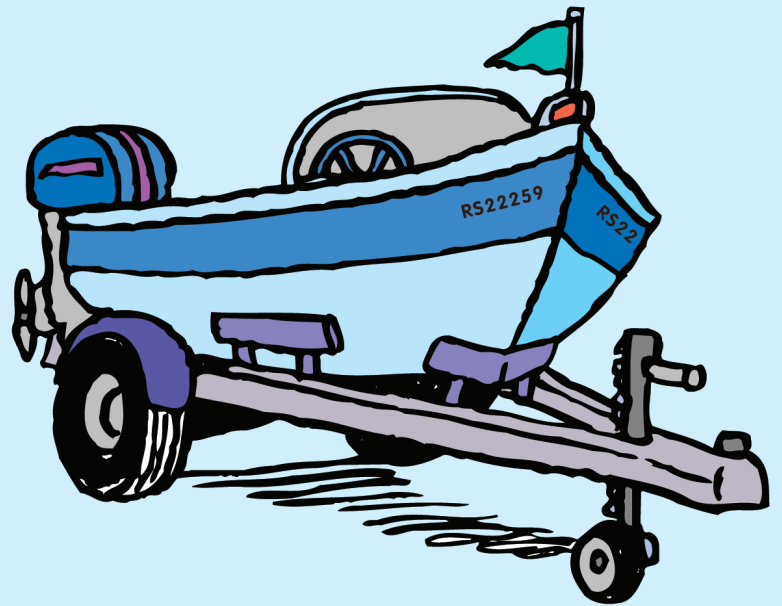
